$\checkmark 2$ years Foreign Language (3 yrs. recommended)

## University (CSU/UC) A-G Requirements

V1 year Visual/Performing Arts
$\checkmark 1$ year College Prep Elective-many options
Other requirements:
"C" grade or higher in all A-G coursework
*SAT/ACT not used for admissions but can be useful.
