## **Aved P. Shaghoian Memorial Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This applicant must be planning to go to college and major in music

## **Bob Koch Athletic Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This is for students who have participated in sports and who are planning to further their education after high school.

## **Brian Jones Memorial Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

The applicant must be accepted to the college or vocational school of his/her choice for the fall term immediately after graduation and intend to pursue a career in Agriculture. **Applicants who have been awarded a full scholarship to an institution (which includes tuition, fees, room and board) from any other source, or sources, will not be eligible to accept this scholarship.** The applicant may have the opportunity to participate in a paid summer internship in agriculture.

## **Clay Elementary School Scholarship**

**Deadline: April 26-Return to Counseling Office.**

Student must have graduated from Clay Elementary and have a 2.0 GPA or higher. All recipients must enroll in school prior to the spring semester of the year following high school graduation or forfeit the scholarship. Proof of college registration is required.

## **Clay School Education Foundation: Reagan Johnson Memorial Scholarship**

**Deadline: April 19-Return to Counseling Office or Clay Elementary.**

Criteria for this scholarship: Student must be a current graduating senior who graduated from Clay Elementary School. 2.5 overall GPA, planning to attend trade school, community college, or university; one character reference is required.

## **Clay School Parent Club Scholarship**

**Deadline: April 26-Return to Counseling Office.**

Student must have graduated from Clay Elementary and have a 2.0 GPA or higher. All recipients must enroll in school prior to the spring semester of the year following high school graduation or forfeit the scholarship. Proof of college registration is required.

## **Dennis W. Jones Memorial Scholarship “The Stump Award”**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Dennis was a KHS 1964 graduate. This offers a scholarship to a student-athlete with an interest in football. The recipient of this award must have the three qualities that the game of football taught Dennis: hard work, the meaning of the word “team,” and the importance of good friendship.

### **Gladys Curtis Cosmetology Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This scholarship is for a graduating senior who is planning to attend a school of cosmetology.

### **Heritage Co. Boutique Future Female Entrepreneur Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This scholarship aims to support a local young woman with plans to pursue a career in business. Must be a high school senior. Application should include a senior profile and short essay.

### **Hillblom Vocational Grant**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This application is for a student who is planning to attend an eligible community college or technical school accredited by a U.S. Department of Education approved agency. It is also defined as a two-year or less vocational/technical program, culminating in an associate degree (not a stepping stone to a bachelor's degree), diploma, or certificate, but less than a bachelor's degree. Student will be selected on academic strength, motivation, intent to complete post-secondary education and financial profile. Awards are up to a maximum of \$7500.00.

### **Holy Family Council 9213 Knights of Columbus Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Applicant must be accepted to the college or vocational school of their choice for the fall term after graduation. Applicant will be evaluated on GPA, financial need, citizenship, school leadership and involvement in clubs, sports, etc.

### **Juan & Elena Cuenca College Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This scholarship is for a student with an interest in business, engineering, or biology. Student must be planning to attend post-secondary in the fall, be of Hispanic descent, and show need for financial assistance.

### **Katie Trevino Memorial**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Applicant must be a Kingsburg High graduate and have plans to enroll in a 4-year college or university in the fall following graduation from high school. Preference will be given to a student planning to attend a UC and major in the field of creative writing or communications, but other college choices or majors will be considered.

### **KHS Football Booster Club Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Applicants need to have participated in the current football season at KHS and have participated in at least one year of varsity football, acceptance or pending acceptance to an institution/program of higher education, must submit official transcripts.

### **KHS Volleyball Boosters Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This scholarship is limited to girls who have participated in the KHS volleyball program for at least three years including the senior year. Students must also have been accepted to a post-secondary institution.

### **Kings River Scholarship**

#### **Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Applicants must have graduated from Kings River School and have a GPA of 2.0 or higher. All recipients must enroll in school prior to the spring semester of the year following graduation or forfeit the scholarship.

### **Kings River Students-Mrs. Quiring Reads Scholarship**

#### **Deadline: May 1 - Return to Counseling Office**

This scholarship is in memory of Mrs. Quiring who was the Kings River Librarian for many years. It will be awarded to a graduating senior who attended Kings River Elementary and is continuing to a 2 or 4-year college or a certified vocational program.

### **Kingsburg Catholic Women's Club Scholarship (For Men and Women)**

#### **Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office or Holy Family Church Office.**

Applicant must be an active member of Holy Family-Kingsburg, St. John the Baptist-Traver, or Santa Cruz-New London, be a member of the senior graduating class, be accepted to a college or vocational school and enrolled as a full-time student (12 units or more). Student must have two reference letters, one from an active Holy Family parishioner and one from a teacher, coach, or leader of a club in which you are involved. Essay on the four Cardinal Virtues required.

### **Kingsburg Community Assistance Programs Scholarship**

#### **Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

The application requires a written statement of educational and personal goals and need for a scholarship. A current financial statement must also be provided.

### **Kingsburg Fine Arts**

#### **Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This scholarship is designed and intended for a graduating senior from Kingsburg High School who will be pursuing post-secondary education in the fine arts.

### **Kingsburg Girls Softball Scholarship**

#### **Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Citizenship, school involvement, GPA, and financial need are considered. Applicant must have played softball, maintained a good GPA, have plans to attend college, and have parents who have participated in the softball program.

### **Kingsburg Gun Club**

#### **Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This scholarship is for a graduating senior who has a parent that belongs to the Kingsburg Gun Club or for a student who has worked at the Gun Club in the last two years.

### **Kingsburg High Agriculture Boosters Scholarship**

#### **Deadline: April 15 by 5:00 pm -Online application-Google forms**

Application will explain criteria and award amounts.

### **Kingsburg High Aquatic Boosters Scholarship**

#### **Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Applicants must have completed at least three seasons of any Aquatic Sport (swimming, diving, water polo-one during the senior year) and be graduating with at least a 2.5 GPA.

### **Kingsburg High Associated Student Body Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This is for those students who have held student body class offices or club offices. A short statement of activities in school that helped promote school spirit or made a difference in your school is required.

### **Kingsburg High School California Scholarship Federation**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This scholarship is for students who have been a paid member of the KHS CSF chapter for at least one semester during their senior year.

### **Kingsburg High Men's Basketball Boosters Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This scholarship is limited to seniors that have participated in the KHS basketball program. The applicant must have applied and been accepted to a post-secondary institution.

### **Kingsburg High Softball Boosters Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This is for students who played high school softball at KHS.

### **Kingsburg High Teachers Association Teacher Candidate Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

The application requires current GPA, goals in wanting to become a teacher, and a listing of club and organization membership or leadership.

### **Kingsburg Maker Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This scholarship is for a senior graduating from KHS who is intending to attend a post-secondary institution. There is no GPA requirement but the student displays a love and dedication to the creative arts. Student must supply a copy of a creative project.

### **Kingsburg Professional Firefighters Association**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must be planning to enroll in a 2 or 4-year college or vocational school to pursue a career in Fire, EMS. It is also open to students that have a relative who is actively employed as a firefighter or EMS.

### **Kingsburg Tuesday Club**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Fill out the application and include GPA, school and community activities, honors/awards, and personal statement.

### **Kingsburg Youth Soccer League Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

The applicant must have participated in the Kingsburg Youth Soccer program and also must have participated in varsity soccer during his/her senior year. Awards are given to one female and one male.

## **Kiwanis Club Scholarship**

### **Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling**

Any graduating senior in the Kingsburg High School District is eligible to apply for this scholarship from their high school. The committee's decision will be based on its assessment of a combination of the applicant's character, maturity, academic and extracurricular achievement, and involvement in school and community activities.

## **Larry Hillblom Memorial Scholarship**

### **Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Applicant must be accepted to the college of his/her choice for the fall term after graduation and be in the top 15% of their graduating class. Those who are awarded a full scholarship to an institution from any other source **will not** be eligible to accept this scholarship award. Also required is a personal autobiographical statement, which also states the reason for applying for this scholarship.

## **Leo Ocampo Memorial Scholarship**

### **Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

In honor of Leo Ocampo (Class of 1999): Student must be a graduate of this year's senior class, have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher, enroll in a 2 or 4-year college and have proof of that enrollment. The recipient of this award should be someone who is not afraid to dream big, displays integrity and strong character and is humble enough to think of others before themselves, just as Leo did.

## **Louie Cardoza Memorial Scholarship-Selma Portuguese Azorian Association**

### **Deadline: Student must mail this application BEFORE April 1.**

Requirements: 3.5 GPA (official transcript required), extracurricular activities, one letter of recommendation by a coach, teacher, or advisor, and a biographical letter.

## **Margaret Chabolla-Delgado Scholarship**

### **Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Scholarships given by Margaret Chabolla-Delgado's children in memory of her strength and independence. Eligibility includes being a graduating female student who is of Hispanic descent (at least 50%) and a child of a single parent household, a U.S. citizen, legal resident or DACA. Minimum 3.0 GPA, planning to enroll full time in an accredited public or nonprofit college; community college or four-year university in the U.S. Must provide two letters of recommendation from teachers, transcript of grades, and verification of financial need.

## **Nicholas Thiessen Memorial Scholarship**

### **Deadline: May 1 - Return to Counseling Office**

Applicants must be a senior in high school with plans to attend a college/university, trade school, or join our armed forces after high school, has a GPA of 3.0 or above, is involved in either an academic extracurricular activity or plays a sport.

## **Price Firefighting Scholarship**

### **Deadline: Student must mail the application before May 1.**

Our mission is to provide financial support to a graduating Kingsburg High School student who plans to major in Fire Science. A scholarship will be awarded to a graduating KHS student who displays courage, integrity, and has achieved the mandatory requirements for the Price Firefighter Scholarship.

### **Price Nursing Scholarship**

**Deadline: Student must mail the application before May 1.**

Our mission is to provide financial support to a graduating Kingsburg High School student who plans to major in Nursing Science. A scholarship will be awarded to a graduating KHS student who displays compassion, integrity, and has achieved the mandatory requirements for the Price Nursing Scholarship.

### **Rafer Johnson Junior High School Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

The Olympian Parent Club is offering a scholarship for a student that has been promoted from RJJH to Kingsburg High School. The student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5, enroll in a post-secondary college or technical/vocational school, complete the application, and write an essay.

### **Rose Gong Memorial Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must have had an immediate family member who has had cancer. The applicant must also be planning to enroll in a 2 or 4-year college or vocational school.

### **Selma Masonic Lodge**

**Deadline: April 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

The requirements for this scholarship are to write a one-page essay on the Masonic Lodge. Tell about a person, place, event, or personal experience that involves the Masons.

### **Send It for Jay Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This scholarship is for a student that enjoys helping others and is also highly creative. Student should have at least a 3.0 GPA, be involved in Ag Mechanics classes, and plan to work in a career technical field.

### **Seth Costas Memorial**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Applicant is asked basic information and to write an essay on how they have made a difference in someone's life and plans for the future.

### **Tague Jones Memorial Science Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Tague Jones was a 2012 graduate of Kingsburg High. He had a passion for science and his family would like to support anyone with a similar passion. To be eligible, the applicant must have an interest in Physics and/or other science; no GPA requirement but must be slated for graduation.

### **Tri-County Family Medical Clinic Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

This scholarship requires information on GPA and academic interests.

### **Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 6152 Scholarship**

**Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Applicant must have a family member or relative who is a veteran and provide a statement regarding educational and personal goals and need for a scholarship.

## **Weston Anderson Scholarship**

### **Deadline: May 1-Return to Counseling Office.**

Applicant must be accepted to the college of his/her choice (2 or 4-year) for the fall term immediately following graduation, be in the top 20% of his/her graduating class, and have a planned major that is within the science field (i.e. chemistry, biology, biochemistry, genetics, physics, engineering, computer science, etc.).
