Fresno State The Usher Program (Computer Science) Scholarship

Deadline: Not identified yet- which means submit your application now!

Annual \$10,000 scholarship for 2-4 years. Faculty and peer mentorship, research, internships, community opportunities and more. Who is eligible? Underrepresented minority or female students in Computer Science, incoming OR transfer students, potential for academic and professional success, financial need, U.S. citizenship.

Asian and Pacific Islander American Scholarship Fund

Deadline: January 9, 2024 (5 pm EST) optional recommendation letter deadline Dec. 6

Scholarship awards range from one-time \$2,500 awards to multi-year \$20,000 awards. APIA Scholars provides scholarships to underserved APIA students with a special focus on those who live at or below the poverty line, or are in the first generation of their family to attend college and are representative of the APIA community's diversity (for more details see the website).

- Be able to describe your ethnicity, heritage, or ancestry in relation to the countries, territories, or lands in Asia or the Pacific Islands
- Be a citizen, national, or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Be enrolling or continuing as a degree-seeking undergraduate student in a U.S. accredited college or university in Fall 2024
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 (unweighted), or equivalent, or have earned a GED
- Must apply for federal financial aid for the 2024-2025 academic year using the Free Application for the Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by early April 2024

Elks Legacy Award

Deadline: February 5, 2024

Legacy Awards are \$4,000 scholarships for graduating high school seniors who are children or grandchildren of living Elks members who joined the order on or before April 1, 2021 or a charter member of a Lodge that was instituted on or after April 1, 2021 and is a paid-up member through March 31, 2024. If you are selected as a 2024 Legacy Awards recipient, you will be required to perform service once a year with an Elks Lodge during the four years you are receiving the scholarship. Deadline: March 13, 2024

Tri Counties Bank offers two types of scholarships:

Income Based — Sixty \$1,500 scholarships are awarded to students with a Student Aid Index of 0 or less and a minimum GPA of 2.5. (You'll know your EFC after you file FAFSA or CADAA.)

Merit Based — Twenty \$1,000 scholarships are offered to students with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
