# SoCalGas Scholarship Deadline: March 19, 2024

<u>4 year University eligibility</u>:Be a high school senior with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent., live in the SoCalGas <u>service territory</u>, plan to attend a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited four-year college or university in the U.S. for the 2024/2025 academic year, plan to enroll in an eligible major in Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, Finance, Accounting. *Medical-related fields are not eligible*, demonstrate financial need.

Community College or Trade School Program Applicants must meet all of the following criteria: Be a high school senior or current college undergraduate with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent., live in the SoCalGas service territory, plan to attend a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two-year college or trade school in the U.S. for the 2024/2025 academic year, plan to enroll in an eligible major in Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, Finance, Accounting, Business Administration, Plumbing, Electrical HVAC, or Welding.
